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TAB Southern Punters Challenge ("THE COMPETITION") TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. All individual entrants must have a verified TAB NZ betting account, and the principal member of each team must have a verified TAB NZ betting account. For collects of \$1,000 or more, a verified TAB NZ account number must be provided.
2. Employees of the Canterbury Jockey Club and any persons under the age of 18 are not eligible to enter the Competition.
3. Entrants (including all team members) will be on-course at Riccarton Park on Saturday 13 April 2024 to enter the Competition.
4. The cost to enter the Competition is \$500 per team, which entitles the entrant/team to a \$500 betting voucher for the Competition. Each individual team member pays \$80 to cover food and beverages. The bar will close 30 minutes after the last race.
5. Contestants must be in the designated area (Balmerino Room) 30 minutes prior to the First Race.
6. A person may enter as an individual or as a team comprising a maximum of five people. A team must have a principal member to whom any winnings will be paid. The make-up and shares of any syndicate are the responsibility of the principal syndicate member.
7. A person may enter the Competition as both an individual and as a member of a team, provided that all entries are accompanied by the \$500 entrance fee.
8. Names of contestants will be disclosed, although a nom de plume may be used for publicity purposes.
9. Registrations must be received by the Canterbury Jockey Club before 6pm Thursday 4 April 2024. The Canterbury Jockey Club reserves the right to cancel the Competition if fewer than 20 registrations are received or amend the prize pool based on entries.
10. The \$500 entrance fee and individual \$80 fees must be received by the Canterbury Jockey Club before 6pm Thursday 4 April 2024, unless special arrangements have been made with the Club.
11. Each betting transaction must start and finish with a deposit betting voucher. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
12. The Competition will be run across Races 1-10 at the Canterbury Jockey Club meeting on Saturday 13 April 2024. Races at other venues are not included in the Competition.
13. A minimum of \$50 must be invested on each of Race or the balance of the voucher if the balance is less than \$50.
14. A contestant will not be disqualified if their entire balance is held up due to an inquiry. If part of their balance is held up due to an inquiry, the minimum investment rule still applies.
15. It is the contestant's responsibility to ensure their investments are placed on time. No claims for incorrect or lost tickets will be considered as part of the competition.
16. The onus to check tickets remains with the contestants, and it is therefore strongly recommended that entrants fill out betting slips to place their bets.
17. This is a tote bet competition. The bet types which cannot be placed are Multi bets, Pick Six, Place6, Six Pack and Triple Trio. No Fixed odds betting is available within this competition.
18. First place of the Competition will be the individual or team who has achieved the highest profit after dividends have been paid out on all races at Riccarton Park. Second and third positions following.
19. A presentation will take place after the last race.
20. Dress is smart race day attire.
